### **HEALTH CARE IN COSTA RICA**

#### 12-DAY PRACTICAL FIELD EXPERIENCE IN COSTA RICA



#### **DAY1&2**

Arrival day and move into homestay or alternate
accommodations. Day 2: In the morning, students receive an
overview of the Healthcare System of Costa Rica and tour of
the Hospital Clínica Bíblica. In the afternoon, students will
visit shadowing locations at different health centers.



#### **DAY 3**

• Students participate in a morning lecture, and in the afternoon engage in a shadowing experience at health care center (\*primary health care, physical therapy, mental health, or general medicine).



#### DAY 4

• In the morning, students go on a guided visit of a local EBAIS (which is health care facility that is part of the Costa Rica's public-private mixed health system), and in the afternoon, take part in shadowing at health care center.\*



#### DAY 5

 A morning to explore San José, to see the cultural spots and parks, boulevards, coffee shops, and its Central Markets to get a taste of what Costa Ricans eat, do and love, followed by an afternoon shadowing experience at health care center.\*



#### DAY 6

• After a guided visit to health referral system in urban and rural settings, students will travel to a small mountain town with breathtaking views of a near-by volcano. Relax at a local hotel while enjoying the scenery.



### **HEALTH CARE IN COSTA RICA**

#### 12-DAY PRACTICAL FIELD EXPERIENCE IN COSTA RICA



#### DAY 7

 Take the morning to enjoy time at thermal springs, and hiking around the volcano. In the afternoon, travel back to San José and have dinner at homestay.



#### DAY8

• Students participate in a morning lecture, and in the afternoon students engage in a shadowing experience at health care center (\*primary health care, physical therapy, mental health, or general medicine).



#### DAY 9

 In the morning, students receive a guided visit to the second level and third level of care clinics, and in the afternoon students engage in a shadowing experience at health care center.\*



#### **DAY 10**

• Students participate in a morning lecture, and in the afternoon students engage in a shadowing experience at health care center (\*primary health care, physical therapy, mental health, or general medicine).



#### **DAY 11 & 12**

• In the morning, participate in a guided visit to the Ministry of Health and Children's Hospital and in the afternoon there will be a program wrap up and farewell dinner. Transport to Airport for return to the US.



## PRACTICAL APPROACHES TO SUSTAINABILITY

#### 12-DAY PRACTICAL FIELD EXPERIENCE IN COSTA RICA



#### **DAY1&2**

 Arrival to Costa Rica and transport to agro-ecological farm, Introduction and tour of the farm, practical work on vegetable garden, History and evolution of agriculture.
 Concept of food security - individual project selection. Enjoy yoga, meditation, cultural activities in the evening.



#### DAY 3

• Explore farming systems - work on soil preparation, organic fertilizer, seed selection, seedlings, permaculture, agroecology, agroforestry, and agricultural systems. Later, students may focus on individual projects and enjoy yoga, meditation, cultural activities in the evening.



#### DAY 4

Explore and hike rivers and trails at some of Costa Rica's
 National Parks that are a bit further off the beaten path,
 nestled in the mountains of the central valley. Enjoy yoga,
 meditation, cultural activities in the evening.



#### DAY 5

 Morning practical work on animal husbandry (goats, chickens), In the afternoon, explore the role of biodiversity in agriculture and food security - group exercise and work on individual project. Enjoy yoga, meditation, cultural activities in the evening.



#### DAY 6

 Day 6 focuses on nutrition and health: students will organize and prepare dinner for farm residents based on current and seasonal farm products. In the afternoon, students will engage in critical debate about food and health.



# PRACTICAL APPROACHES TO SUSTAINABILITY

#### 12-DAY PRACTICAL FIELD EXPERIENCE IN COSTA RICA



#### DAY 7

• Discover Costa Rica's volcanoes and breathtaking views at a national park on the outskirts of the central valley.



#### DAY8

 Morning work in medicinal plant garden, and in the afternoon agriculture for non-edible purposes (construction, clothing, medicine). Enjoy yoga, meditation, cultural activities in the evening.



#### DAY 9

 Visit a near-by forest in the morning, and get your hands dirty with practical work while exploring the concept of forest rehabilitation. In the afternoon, debate on Green revolution, agrochemicals, and GMOs.



#### **DAY 10**

 Students' project presentation during the morning, and in the afternoon deep-dive into the Costa Rican experience (the shift towards sustainable development), finishing with course evaluation.



#### **DAY 11 & 12**

 Day in San José to see the capital's cultural spots and parks, boulevards, coffee shops, and its Central Markets to get a taste of what Costa Ricans eat, do and love. Lunch at the Central Market. Transport to Airport for return to the US.



### **FOOD AND CULTURE IN COSTA RICA**

#### 8-DAY PRACTICAL FIELD EXPERIENCE



#### **DAY1&2**

 Arrival to San José. Discover Costa Rica's volcanoes and breathtaking views at a national park. Tour a local farm to learn about organic agriculture, production and sustainable practices, farmers' markets, intuitive eating, and traditional and modern cuisine.



#### DAY 3

 Day in San José to see the capital's cultural spots and parks, boulevards, coffee shops, and its Central Markets to get a taste of what Costa Ricans eat, do and love. Lunch at the Central Market and a visit one of the museums downtown.



#### DAY 4

• Experience a wonderful edible garden with unique flavors, fragrances, and colors. Pick exotic seasonal fruit and evergreens that you will never forget. Plant a tree for future generations and take a hike down the waterfall path.



#### DAY 5

 Visit international coffee farm and global research and development hub. Coffee experience with a non-profit social enterprise working in Costa Rica's Los Santos region, dedicated health, and general support for smallholder women coffee famers.



#### DAY 6

 On a two-day gastronomic tour, experience port cities on the Pacific, and the local gastronomic traditions, culture, products and recipes. Enjoy a relaxing overnight at the beach. Visit a fishing cooperative focused on sustainable fishing methods, conservation of the local ecosystem and economy.



#### **DAY 7 & 8**

 Farewell Dinner at a restaurant specializing in indigenous gastronomy and culture, with 85% of their products provided by indigenous communities. Depart to the US.



# SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND SUSTAINABILITY

#### 10-DAY PRACTICAL FIELD EXPERIENCE



#### DAY 1

• Arrival in San José, airport pick up and transfer to hotel. Welcome dinner & overnight stay at hotel in San José



#### DAY 2

 Travel to the Central Caribbean to a Rainforest nature reserve and eco-adventure park. Learn about the socioeconomic and environmental background of the location, local business plans and challenges overcome. At night, explore the bat conservation project.



#### DAY 3

 Visit mountain community for a rural educational experience learning about sustainable growing methods, local dairy farm production, prepare Costa Rican snacks with fresh ingredients picked by your group, and interact with locals + research team.



#### DAY 4

 Travel to San Marcos de Tarrazú to begin exploring the coffee sector of Costa Rica. Coffee tasting, hands-on experience at the farm, learn about processing methods, discuss challenges in production, particularly for small businesses owned by women.



#### DAY 5

 A specific case study/challenge will be presented by the local team in charge, and the design thinking approach (empathy, ideation, prototype, presentation) will be used for students to work on in groups throughout the day.



# SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND SUSTAINABILITY

#### 10-DAY PRACTICAL FIELD EXPERIENCE



#### DAY 6

 Travel back to San José and take the afternoon to relax. Introduction to Fundación ALIARSE: context info on managerial system of public-private partnerships and current projects.



#### DAY 7

 Visit some of the stakeholders involved in the process of decarbonization of the Costa Rican economy. Site visits will include presentation of case related to current issue/project and will give students time for brainstorming for ideas or solutions.



#### DAY8

 Site visits to sector-specific locations working in the areas of recycling, health, and others. Some examples of possible visits are: Costa Rica Social Security System (CCSS), Coca Cola Co.: Recycling & water.



#### DAY 9

 Adventure a volcano at a national park and visit local strawberry farm and restaurant. Afternoon time to explore San José on your own, getting an idea of the country's capital city; streets, food, culture and shops. Farewell dinner!



#### **DAY 10**

• Pick up at hotel & transfer to airport. Depart Costa Rica.
